Our Lady asked us to pray the Holy Rosary for the CONVERSION OF SINNERS and IN REPARATION FOR THE SINS OF THE WORLD on many occasions, and this we would gladly do; but, at the same time, I encourage you to ask her as well -aside from our PERSONAL INTENTIONS-, for the CHURCH'S PROTECTION FROM THE DEVIL, for the preparations of the SYNOD 2023 which will begin this month; for PEACE in the world; for all those who are SUFFERING in this world due to pandemic, war, terrorism, persecution, illness, poverty, injustices, unemployment etc.; and, for the HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY.
