**First Holy Communion** This last eighteen months has been difficult for us all, especially trying to organise programmes of Catechesis, but the road ahead seems much brighter and we will be starting the programme in September.

This coming year things will be slightly different due to us having two year groups to work with.

The programme will begin in September and classes will be held on Saturday mornings in St. Mary's parish hall. There will be two classes running consecutively; one from 9-10am the second from 10.15-11.15am.

The sessions will run once a month from September until June (10 sessions), with the children making their First Holy Communions during July 2022. These Masses will take place on a Saturday morning over 4 weekends.

Further details of who is assigned to each class and at which Mass your child will receive First Holy Communion will be given during a Parents Meeting which will be held on **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> September**.

If your child is presently in year 3 and you completed forms previously, details of the parents meeting have been posted to you. If your child will be in year 3 from September 2021 and you wish them to receive First Holy Communion in July 2022, then you must complete the forms that are available on the [parish website](#) and provide us with all the relevant documentation no later than the **25<sup>th</sup> July**. ***This closing date will be strictly adhered to due to the current numbers we have.*** Details of the parents meeting will be sent soon after the closing date.

If you have any questions or have difficulty accessing the forms on the website please contact the parish secretary (details on the back page of this newsletter).

**Confirmation** Plans are underway to reschedule the postponed Confirmation classes beginning in September this year, with the Confirmation Mass being celebrated in early November. Any young person who will be in **Yr9 or above from September 2021** who is interested in joining the Confirmation group, and hasn't already applied in either 2020 or 2021, is asked to download the form available from the *Sacraments* page on the [parish website](#) print and complete it. Once your parent/guardian has also signed it, return it to St. Mary's Presbytery by **Friday 23 July 2021 (i.e. the end of this term)**.
