Need to talk? A new ministry has been launched in the Diocese of East Anglia to provide prayerful listening for those who need to talk to someone. Pairs of trained helpers will listen and pray with any adult who feels they would like someone to listen to their concerns. The listeners have received training in prayer, listening, safeguarding and data protection, and they have all had a DBS check.

This confidential service is available at a number of centres round the diocese, including Ipswich, and also online on Zoom. If you would like to use the service you can leave a message at: 01603 957653. All calls are confidential and calls will be returned within 48 hours. This number is not a helpline but a booking system, and it is important to understand that this is not a crisis service

Parishioners will be offered an initial consultation and then five or six further meetings to work through their personal concerns in a safe, trusting environment.
