**Feast of SS Peter & Paul—29 June** is a Holy Day, but not a day of obligation. At the start of the pandemic obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days was removed and this instruction has not yet been reversed. Mass will be celebrated on **Tuesday 29 June** at **9.15am** in **St. Mary's** for those who feel able to attend. In addition, on this occasion, a **Vigil Mass** for the feast will be celebrated on **Monday 28 June** at **6pm** in **Holy Family** church.

We want everyone to understand that in these emergency circumstances, and for as long as they last, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days is removed. This is, without doubt, the teaching of the Church (Catechism of the Catholic Church 2181). This pandemic is the 'serious reason' why this obligation does not apply at this time.
